## HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE FE

As of October 1, 2019, the Florida Board of Professional Engineers (FBPE) has updated the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) registration process. Please follow the steps below to satisfy the CECE FE requirement. FE results are due before the end of your last semester. It is in your best interest not to wait until the last minute to register for the FE Exam.

1. Apply directly with [NCEES.org](https://www.ncees.org) to register to take the exam (\$175) and schedule the exam date with Pearson Testing Center.
2. Exam results are typically available within 10 business days. You will receive an email notification from NCEES with instructions to view your exam results in your MyNCEES account.
3. You will need to provide the CECE office with the “Verifiable Link” to your exam, which is posted within your NCEES Account. **The verifiable link is the only acceptable form of FE verification. RESULTS ARE DUE BEFORE THE END OF YOUR LAST SEMESTER.**
4. Within 7 days of receiving your FE Results, the CECE will notify you via email that your degree audit has been updated.

### **Please Note:**

- Only **AFTER** you have earned your bachelor’s degree and passed the FE exam, are you eligible to apply for Engineer Intern (EI) certification in Florida through the Florida Board of Professional Engineers (FBPE.org). If you have questions regarding the EI or the process to register, please contact the FBPE at (850) 521-0500.
- **If you need to submit official transcripts: Official Transcripts must be ordered online through the MyUCF portal from the Registrar’s office. UCF does not offer unofficial transcripts. The CECE department does not provide transcripts. If you have any questions regarding UCF transcripts, please contact the Registrar’s office.**
